

Intimate partner violence is behaviour by an intimate or ex-partner that causes physical, sexual, emotional, financial, social, or spiritual harm.

- 2,462 Nova Scotians a year are abused by an intimate partner.¹
- **4** in 5 victims of intimate partner violence are women.²
- 67% of Canadians know at least one woman who has experienced physical or sexual abuse.³



Physical and emotional healing requires time and support in a safe, stable environment. Many women cannot escape abuse because they have no place to go.
