Private, secure spaces are at the heart of this work, offering the stability needed for survivors to heal and rebuild their lives.



Adopt-a-Space and Make a Direct Impact

Adopt-a-Space is an initiative that allows donors to directly support these spaces. By "adopting" a **room** or a **home** for one **year or more**, you ensure that a critical space is ready, welcoming, and fully equipped for the work of healing. It's a tangible way to underwrite the essential costs of our charitable programs and support our clients' journeys from crisis to stability.

Adopt a specific space in our Drop-in Centre, keeping it welcoming, safe, and available for our free programs like trauma counselling and food security. Your gift keeps that space ready for healing work every day.

Adopt-a-Home (Safe Housing Unit)

Adopt one of our 18 confidentially located, second-stage housing units and provide a family with safety and peace of mind. By adopting a home, you help us provide survivors with a secure home rented for 70% below market rate, where they can focus on rebuilding their lives.
